

**ENYA 2017**

**The Road to RIO: *Exploring  
and empowering youth  
identity and relationships***

- 11 Participating Countries:

- Azerbaijan
- Belgium
- Cyprus
- France
- Greece
- Italy
- Malta
- Poland
- Spain (Catalonia)
- Scotland
- Wales



- A group was set up in each of the participating countries and consisted of 10-15 young people between the ages of 14 and 17.
- A series of meetings were held (between 6 and 10).
- Main themes discussed:  
Respect, Access to information, Voicing their opinion, Social Environment and the Impact of new technologies.
- The young people proposed a set of recommendations.

- 2 representatives were then chosen from each participating country to attend the ENYA Seminar which was held in Paris between the 29<sup>th</sup> and the 30<sup>th</sup> of June.



- During the ENYA Seminar various activities were carried out for the young to get to know each other.



- Each country presented their own recommendations.



- Recommendations were then put together and divided into 4 sections:  
Government, Education/Schools, Health and Community/Digital Rights/Media.



- An interactive discussion session was held between the Ombudspersons present and the young people.
- The young people highlighted their priorities and also expressed new ideas.



- At the end of the seminar the young people were divided into four different groups in order to discuss the consolidated recommendations and to prioritise them.
