



The Guidelines and Ombudspersons

States should, where appropriate, also provide children and/or their parents or legal representatives with non-judicial mechanisms, administrative or other means to seek remedy, such as through ombudspersons for children and other national human rights institutions and data-protection authorities

Paragraph 70, Guidelines

Provision of remedies

11

States should <u>engage</u> all relevant stakeholders, such as <u>ombudspersons</u> for <u>children</u> and other independent human rights institutions (...) in the design, drafting, implementation and evaluation of a national strategy or action plan.

Engagement at all stages




